Visa Info

South African passport holders will need to apply for a visa to be an Au Pair for 1 year in France. Your OVC consultant will assist you with this process.
 EU passport holders do not need to apply for a visa.

Placements in Paris and the outskirts of Paris.

A placement in Paris is a bit different to elsewhere. Most of the time Parisians live in apartments and have independent accommodation for their Au Pair on the top floor of their building or within walking distance from their home. These rooms are called 'chambre de service'. An Au Pair who wants to be placed in Paris therefore has to be quite an independent person and be happy not to be with the host family all the time.

Host families who live on the outskirts of Paris are located a maximum of one hour away from Paris center and most of the time 15 to 30 minutes away. The Au Pairs placed in these areas benefit from a more quiet life but can get easily and quickly to the center of Paris. Confident drivers are a must for this location.

Placements in the South of France - experienced and confident driver is a must.
